



**LEGAL ALERT: TEMPORARY PROCEDURE FOR DETERMINATION OF LEVEL OF THE
COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND REGULATION OF ACTIVITIES OF GOVERNMENT
ORGANIZATIONS, INDIVIDUALS, AND LEGAL ENTITIES**

The Government of Mongolia has approved a “Temporary Procedure for Determination of the Level of COVID-19 Pandemic and Regulation of Activities of Government organizations, Individuals and Legal Entities” on 21 February 2021.

Four levels of the pandemic have been identified and working procedure of government organizations, individuals, and legal entities at each level have been regulated in the procedure and the working procedure for legal entities is outlined in this alert.

Territorial shift to enhanced preparedness wholly or partially and establishment of quarantine and restriction regime for the activities of state organizations, individuals, and legal entities within certain limits shall be taken.

Restricted activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Any competitions and contests; - Trips (except for family trips); - Exhibitions and trade fairs; - Bar (disco); - Electronic gaming center, kids play centers.
Work procedure	Gathering of people not more than 30 at the same time (keep at least 2 meters distance)
Participation in traffic	07.00-00.00
Public transportation	Regular schedule
Work-place regime	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Adhere to infection control guidelines - Register employees, civil servants, and customers placing QR code

Orange level***

****(the infection is spread from a new hotbed)*

Territorial shift to enhanced preparedness wholly or partially and establishment of quarantine and restriction regime for the activities of state organizations, individuals, and legal entities within certain limits shall be taken.

Emergency Regime	Enhanced preparedness
Restricted activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Demonstrations, gatherings, competitions, contests - Trips, weddings, celebrations, banquets, and receptions - Clubs (disco, karaoke) - Exhibitions and trade fairs - Electronic and all kinds of gaming center - Institutions (academic and practice training – up to 10 people per class) - Art, culture

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Entertainment (up to 30% of the total number of seats) - Massage and wellness centers - Fitness centers (up to 30% of the total capacity) - Sauna and swimming pools (up to 30% of the total capacity) - Motels - Religious activities, churches, monasteries, and places of worship - Sport events other than preparation for the Olympics, and continental, world and international competitions (up to 10 people per a room)
Work procedure	Gathering of people not more than 10 people at the same time (keep at least 2 meters distance)
Participation in traffic	07.00-22.00 <i>/with personal vehicles – only the employees of organizations in non-restricted sectors shall participate in traffic with relevant documents/</i>
Public transportation	Regular schedule
Work-place regime	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Shift to special regime (work for extended or shortened hours, work remotely and in shift) - Arrange the work and lunch hours of employees differently - Adhere to infection control guidelines - Register employees, civil servants, and customers placing QR code

<i>**** (the infection is widespread in the population)</i>	
<i>Territorial shift to public emergency preparedness wholly or partially, and establishment of quarantine and restriction regime for the activities of state organizations, individuals, and legal entities shall be taken.</i>	
Emergency Regime	Public emergency preparedness
Non-restricted activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Power, heat, and water supply; - Medical institutions, pharmacies, suppliers of medicine and medical equipment; - Advocacy and notary;

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fuel supply; - Manufacture, trade, transportation, distribution, supply, and packaging of food and household goods; - Sanitary, disinfection, waste disposal, loading, collection, and transportation; - Electron banking, automated teller machine; - Manufacture, supply, distribution, transportation, and trade of agriculture, fodder, fuel; - Telecommunication, courier service; - Activities of business entities that ensure regular activities of the national substantial and strategically important objects and special-purpose organizations (upon approval of the competent authority); - Media (restriction of the right); - Security organizations with the permission of the competent authority; - Geology, exploration, mining, and oil production; - Apartment owners associations; - Funeral services.
Work procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Employees of the non-restricted organizations may: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Come and go to work; • Perform work duties. - Repair service and manufacture and distribution of the non-restricted organizations are allowed.
Participation in traffic	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 07.00-21.00 (no time limit for food production and fuel distribution) - No restriction for urgent need of medical care (e.g. diagnosed with diseases such as cancer, dialysis, pregnancy, trauma, emergency surgery etc. and have medical opinion) and funeral service. - Employees of the non-restricted organizations may participate in traffic with their personal vehicles having a work reference and work ID.
Public transportation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - In the line approved by the emergency commission; - Switch the schedule to special mode; - 1 passenger skipping 1 seat; - Distance keeping;

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use only when urgent.
Work-place regime	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Shift to special regime (work for extended or shortened hours, work remotely and in shift); - Adhere to the guidance by professional organizations; - Register employees, civil servants, and customers placing QR code - Appoint a replacement employee; - Organize meetings and conferences online; - Adhere to infection control guidelines.
